



Petition organised by the St Vincent de Paul Society to the House of Commons.

We are gravely concerned about the manner in which all asylum seekers are currently treated in the UK. The 2015/6 Immigration Bill threatens to make those seeking sanctuary even more vulnerable, leaving more families homeless, and further isolating an already marginal group.

We believe we have a moral responsibility as Christians to be a voice for those who have no voice, for as Pope Francis reminds us, refugees and asylum seekers are our brothers and sisters.

We deeply regret the exclusion of the recommendations of the All Party Parliamentary Inquiry into the Use of Immigration Detention, and we urge the government to reconsider and to adopt these recommendations.
