

















The Number of Endangered Species is Rising




The most important number of the climate crisis:





Ecological justice



- Ecological crisis is likely to lead to inequalities within and across nations, and between current and future generations, so creating injustice.
- We do not want to widen inequalities yet the ecological crisis will likely exacerbate inequitable social conditions

Fairness and Social Justice


Seeing the dignity of all our brothers and sisters as God's children, working for a healthy world for all, and understanding the impact of our activities & actions on our brothers & sisters.


