## Homelessness is a growing global crisis...without a coherent global response

- Multiple pressures are coalescing which will accelerate the crisis: chronic housing shortages, climate change, conflict, mass displacement, and much more.
- **Absent** from the SDGs, homelessness has no effective international coordination, limited international collaboration, and is grossly underfunded.
- **The landmark 2023 UN report on global homelessness** stressed that global cooperation and knowledge-sharing will be essential in ending homelessness.
