The Mini Vinnies are the youngest members of the St Vincent de Paul Society (SVP), an international Christian voluntary organisation dedicated to tackling poverty in all its forms by providing practical assistance to people in need.

The Mini Vinnies get together in primary schools and parishes to live out their mission of see, think, do, supporting their school community and beyond.

## What happens at a Mini Vinnies meeting?

Mini Vinnies groups meet once a week or fortnightly during lunchtime or after school. They are either co-ordinated by school staff, an SVP Conference member, or a combination of both. A president is elected by the Mini Vinnies to lead meetings and organise the group. They are supported by a vice president, a secretary, a communications officer, a treasurer and members. The president opens the meeting with a prayer, and a short spiritual reflection, a reading, a piece of music or meditation follows. Group members talk about activities they have done since the last meeting. Any future plans are then discussed. The president concludes the meeting with a prayer.











## Setting up your Mini Vinnies group

- You complete the online application form at www.svp.org.uk/apply-start-new-youngvincentians-group
- We'll then send you some initial starter literature and we aim to put you in touch with one of our volunteer Young Vincentian Development Officers (YVDO) to help get you set up
- You'll organise a date with the YVDO to visit school to talk to you, and possibly the children, about Mini Vinnies

- It's then time to recruit your Mini Vinnies and have your first meeting
