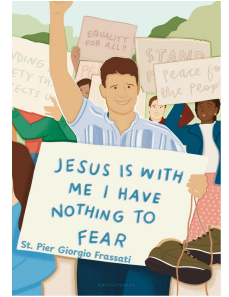




November 1st – All Saints Day
