## **Resources needed:**

Slide 1: Holding Page

**Slide 2:** Play the Rosary video (0-2.20) or in your own words explain why we pray the Rosary/origins of the Rosary/ how to pray the Rosary (especially if you have new people joining you)

**Slide 3:** The Rosary is a prayer that reflects on key events in the life of Jesus and Mary. These events are called the mysteries of the Rosary, and they are divided into four groups:

- Joyful Mysteries focus on Jesus' early life.
- Luminous Mysteries focus on His ministry.
- Sorrowful Mysteries focus on His suffering and death.
- Glorious Mysteries focus on His resurrection and glory.

Each mystery is not just a story to recall, but a spiritual window—a way to see how God is at work in the world, and how we're called to live as disciples. (**Optional**-A decade is comprised on 1 Our Father, 10 Hail Mary's and 1 Glory Be. At the end of each decade we say the Fatima prayer.)

**Slide 4:** St Pier Giorgio Frassati, a young adult member of the SVP, had a deep devotion to the Rosary. When his illness, Polio, got progressively worse, he gave away his Rosaries to his friends and inspired them to continue to pray the Rosary.

**Slide 5:** Let's take a moment to remind ourselves we are in the presence of God and prepare ourselves for prayer..... in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen. We start with the Apostle's Creed, 1 Our Father, 3 Hail Mary's and 1 Glory Be, before we announce the first mystery.
