



## Ideas and Dates for the Diary-January

### January 1st- World Day of Peace

World Day of Peace, celebrated on January 1 every year, is primarily a Catholic feast day dedicated to universal peace on the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God. On this occasion, the Pope generally makes authoritative declarations on the Catholic Social Teachings (C.S.T.). Although you will not be in school with your Mini Vinnies on this date, you might like to reflect on the Pope's message when back at school to unpack with the Mini Vinnies as to how that message will help them on their mission with the SVP. You could also invite your Mini Vinnies to create some posters with the heading "Peace be with you" (Jn 20:19), depicting what this means to them?



### New Year's resolutions

Use this month to unpack with your Mini Vinnies what New Year's resolutions are. What goals could you set as a group that makes the most of the fresh start that the New Year brings? How can you ensure you are continuing to follow in Christ's footsteps to live out the Mini Vinnies' mission of *See, Think, Do*? This might be a good time to review the Mini Vinnies' Pledge and set some goals around that. Why not use our [Kindness Calendar](#) to kick start the year?



### January 19th -Brew Monday

This annual awareness day encourages people to connect with others over a cup of tea or coffee. It aims to combat loneliness and provide emotional support, especially during the winter months when people may be feeling more isolated. Could your Mini Vinnies plan a coffee morning, or afternoon tea for parishioners to attend? Why not use our [Gather the SVP Family resources](#) to help plan an event?



### January 24th - International Day of Education

A celebration of the role of education for peace and development. Invite your Mini Vinnies to discuss why education is important and think about what things we should learn in order to give us the skills, values and mindsets ready to tackle the world's biggest challenges. What topic could they share with others at school to raise awareness and teach their peers about? Why not invite them to [do an assembly](#) on their chosen subject?

### February 2nd – Feast of the Presentation of the Lord

The Presentation of the Lord is always celebrated 40 days after Christmas and brings the season of Christmas to an end. Why not read about it in our updated Mini Vinnies Spiritual Reflection Guide? With reflections and activities, it's a great resource to explore scripture and put our faith into action.



### February 7th – Feast of Bl Rosalie Rendu

Blessed Rosalie Rendu was a French Catholic member of the Daughters of Charity who organized care for the poor in Paris. She helped Blessed Frédéric Ozanam and his friends turn their concern into action. 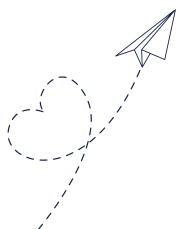


### February 11th – Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, World Day for the sick

On Feb. 11, the Catholic Church celebrates the liturgical memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes, recalling a series of 18 appearances that the Blessed Virgin Mary made to a 14-year-old French peasant girl, Saint Bernadette Soubirous. Explore this story with your Mini Vinnies. St Bernadette is the patron saint of illness, so the Church also acknowledges World Day for the Sick on the 11th. Perhaps your Mini Vinnies can make cards for those who are unwell in your community. Why not contact your local parish priest and make some cards for those on the parish sick list?

### February 14th – Valentine's Day

February is a month to show love, and while Valentine's Day is on the 14th, it's a great time to spread kindness. Consider making [cards of kindness](#) or writing letters for those isolated in your community or parish. Check with local care homes, nursing homes, churches, or SVP community support centres to see where help is needed and get creative!



### February 17th – Random Acts of Kindness Day

This awareness day is the perfect opportunity for your Mini Vinnies to use our [Chain of Kindness resource](#). Each time they do something kind today or this week, they can write it on a paper chain link. See how many chains of kindness they can make!

### February 18th – April 2nd– SVP Heart to Heart Lent Campaign

The SVP is inviting all schools and parishes to take part in our [SVP Heart to Heart Lent campaign](#). We are offering resources for each week of Lent, with the aim of bringing communities together and helping lift people out of loneliness.



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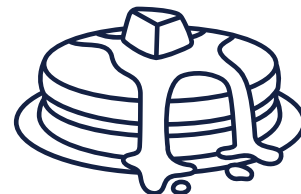
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## Ideas and Dates for the Diary- February/March

### February 17th- Shrove Tuesday

Shrove Tuesday, also called Pancake Day, is the day before Lent starts on Ash Wednesday. This is our tradition of using up what's left in the cupboards before fasting for Lent. Perhaps you and your Mini Vinnies can make some pancakes together, and serve them at a coffee-morning! Or how about a pancake flip-a-thon to raise money for the SVP?



### February 18th- Ash Wednesday/Beginning of Lent

Lent is a time for prayer, fasting and almsgiving (charity). This week, your Mini Vinnies could focus on what they can give to others during Lent. Make sure you check out our [SVP Heart to Heart Lent campaign](#) resources, with weekly activities and a creative display to get involved with!

### March 5th - World Book Day

World Book Day is a celebration of the joy of reading, and a call for universal access to reading. Why don't your Mini Vinnies do a book collection? Why not visit a local care home to read to residents? Or have 'Reading Buddies' at school or in the parish.



### March 8th - International Women's Day

International Women's Day is a global day, celebrating the achievements of women and a call to action for equality. It has been celebrated since the early 1900s! Our Vincentian patrons and founders include 2 amazing women: Bl Rosalie Rendu and St Louise de Marillac. ### March 15th- Mother's Day

Let's celebrate all mothers and motherly figures today! Your Mini Vinnies could write a card or make a crafty present for their mothers or someone they look up to. 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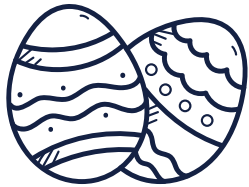
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## Ideas and Dates for the Diary-April

### April 22nd- Earth Day

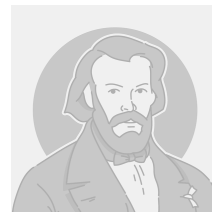

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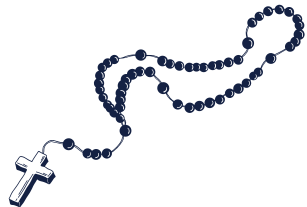
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## Ideas and Dates for the Diary-May

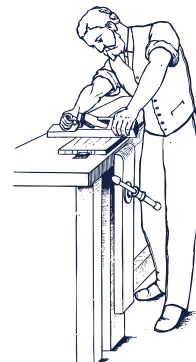


### **Pray the Rosary with the SVP**

### **May 11th - May 17th- Mental Health Awareness Week**

How could your Mini Vinnies support children in school with their mental health? Could they create some calming boxes for others to use at playtime, or lead on an assembly to raise awareness during this week?

### June 7- The Big Lunch

The Big Lunch happens every year in the UK to bring people together, encouraging friendlier, safer communities. It's a great time for people to share ideas, skills, resources and friendship. ### June 1-7 - Volunteers' Week

Volunteers' Week is a chance to recognise, celebrate and thank the UK's incredible volunteers for all they contribute to local communities, the voluntary sector, and society as a whole. Could your Mini Vinnies share with the school about their volunteering experience, or why not organise an event or make cards of thanks for those who volunteer at school or in the parish?



### June 5- World Environment Day

People from all over the world can do something positive to help our planet. What ideas could your Mini Vinnies come up with to live out their promise of caring for God's creation? How about litter-picking in the playground that day? Why not get the Mini Vinnies to plan an awareness raising assembly about recycling?



### June 5- Thank you Day

This day first came about in 2021 to appreciate the unsung heroes in local communities who contributed their time and resources to making life better for people during the COVID-19 pandemic. Every year it now gives people a chance to thank those unsung heroes in their communities that make a big difference. Why not get the Mini Vinnies to think of ideas for thanking those in their communities?



### June 15-21 - Refugee Week

The theme for Refugee Week 2025 is "Community as a Super Power". A chance to focus on our collective power to shape hopeful futures. The SVP Forget-me-not campaign encourages our Young Vincentians to reflect and learn about the experiences of people seeking sanctuary in our country. Why not explore these resources, which can easily be adapted for this week?



### June 21- World Music Day

Do your Mini Vinnies play a musical instrument? Could they brighten up the day by planning a mini concert? Why not see if your local care home would like a visit to celebrate this day?

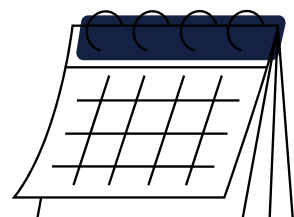


### Good Care Month

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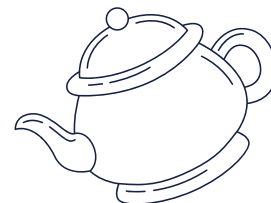


## Ideas and Dates for the Diary – September

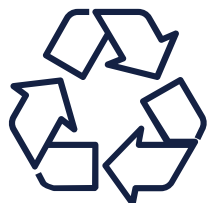


### September 18– National Fitness Day

### October 1- International Day of Older Persons

Could your Mini Vinnies make cards for older people to show their appreciation, or make a visit to the local care home?

### October 10- World Mental Health Day

World Mental Health Day is about coming together to talk about mental health and show everyone that mental health matters. What can your Mini Vinnies plan for this day? Perhaps they can create a quiet space for people to relax, or write **cards of kindness** for those going through a tough time.



### October 17- International Anti-Poverty Day
